Emergency Medical Care

Small wounds will be cleaned with soap and water and protected with bandaids. Parents will receive an injury report on all minor injuries. If a child is in need of medical treatment his parent will be informed immediately. In absolute emergencies, the staff will need to call 911 before calling the parents. Signing the medical form gives authorization for Prairie Baptist Preschool to act on your behalf in an emergency.

Dress Code

We want to teach our children to dress appropriately. Students are expected to be neat and well groomed. Clothing size should be appropriate for the size of the student. It is also our desire to avoid pictures, symbols and messages on clothing that are at a variance with the biblical lifestyle we are trying to teach at Prairie Baptist Preschool.

Girls

- Modest blouses/shirts/nice t-shirts (no inappropriate wording/pictures)
- Modest skirts/dresses (hemlines must come at least to the knee) or approved culottes
- Shoes or sandals must be worn. (No flip flops)

Boys

- Appropriate shirts (undershirts may only be worn under another shirt)
- Pants/jeans in good repair
- Shoes or sandals must be worn. (No flip flops)

Church Affiliation

Enrollment

Enrollment, health and emergency forms must be completed and returned along with the registration fee before a child can be considered. These forms are available in the school office or on line.

Age Requirements

K3 - must be 3 before June 1

K4 - must be 4 before June 1

(All students must be fully toilet trained.)

School Closings

Weather-related closings will be publicized on television station WWMT (channel 3), WOOD (channel 8) and radio stations WBCK/WBXX (FM 95.3/104.9) and WKZO (AM 590). If school is closed for any reason other than weather, you will be contacted by phone at home or at the work/emergency numbers you have provided.

Financial commitments must be made by year. Our classes are staffed according to enrollment therefore parents are responsible for the entire year's tuition even if the student withdraws or is asked to withdraw.

All fees are due at the time of enrollment. Tuition is payable in full or in monthly installments August-May.

Lunch

Parents are responsible for providing snacks and lunch for their child. There is a refrigerator available for storing lunches if needed. Be sure that everything is properly labeled with your child's name. With appropriate instructions the staff will be happy to heat anything in the micro-wave.
